- 1. Lack of Regular Use: Cars that sit unused for extended periods can develop issues such as dried-out seals, battery degradation, and fuel system problems.
- 2. Odometer Rollback: Fraudulent activity like odometer tampering can make mileage appear artificially low. It's essential to verify the mileage history through reliable sources.
- 3. Short Trips: Vehicles driven primarily for short trips may have low mileage but higher wear on the engine, as frequent stops can strain components.
- 4. Maintenance Neglect: A lightly used car may still require regular maintenance, such as oil changes, even if it hasn't been driven much. Lack of service records can be a cause for concern.


